Educating students with special needs

Our dedicated teachers and staff of our Minnick Schools guide students ages 5 to 22 as they overcome challenges to find success in the classroom. We help students reach academic, behavioral, vocational, and developmental goals so they can return to public school or make the transition to life after school. Minnick Schools are located in Bristol, Harrisonburg, Roanoke, Wytheville, and Wise.

Supporting people with disabilities

EnCircle offers adults with developmental disabilities an array of community-based supports. We provide a variety of residential options through our Group Homes (in VA and WV), Family Care Homes, and In-Home Services, including specialized Skilled Nursing for those with complex health-care needs. We also support full community inclusion through Day Support, Community Engagement, and Coaching services.

Strengthening mental health and well-being

Our team of experienced counselors help children, adolescents, adults, and entire families work through such

complex challenges as: grief and loss, anxiety and depression, coping strategies, improving self-esteem, and interpersonal skills. By offering both telehealth and in-person options, our counselors are available to those in need throughout Virginia.

Welcoming immigrants

EnCircle partners with Lutheran Immigration and Refugee Services to help reunite unaccompanied immigrant children with family or sponsors in the U.S. We work to ensure that children in reunited families have the resources they need to heal and thrive. We also partner with Lutheran Social Services of the National Capital Area to support adult immigrants preparing for immigration hearings.

Wrapping support around kids in foster care

We recruit and train Richmond and Tidewater adults eager to share their skills, strengths, courage, and "life firsts" with children who have experienced trauma or need extra support. Our program is committed to helping children find permanency and stability. We welcome families of all faiths and backgrounds, and we support LGBTQ parents and youth.



EnCircle is a not-for-profit organization providing services in Virginia and West Virginia to children, adults, and families. Our 600-plus staff members and caregivers are guided by our vision that all people in our communities will receive the support they need to live abundant lives.

We were founded by a Lutheran pastor as a Salem, VA, orphanage in 1888, serving children from across the South



who needed a home. We have expanded the ways we support people in our communities throughout our long history. As a proud mission partner of the



Virginia Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, we include people of all faiths, backgrounds, and abilities.
